**Lovin' Literacy** (\$350.00: *Includes initial screening and a weekly 45 minute session from July 6<sup>th</sup> until August 3rd*) Groups are conducted by Tovah Segelman, a reading specialist and speech-language pathologist. This program is dedicated to helping children struggling with reading, spelling and writing. It promotes improved phonics, reading, spelling, writing, vocabulary, comprehension, and speaking skills. Our program breaks down and reviews skills from last year and pre-teaches new skills prior to entering the next school year. Language-based reading therapy boosts self-esteem, relieves academic frustration, and lessens homework battles.

**Happy Handwriting** (\$350.00: *Includes initial screening and a weekly 45 minute session from July 6<sup>th</sup> until August 3rd*) Groups are led by Diana Owens, an occupational therapist. She implements The Handwriting without Tears © program, which is an engaging program designed to improve handwriting skills. It is a multi-sensory program used for children from pre-school to late grammar school. It addresses writing skills, such as letter formation, spacing, sizing of letters and line regard (print or cursive), correct grasp pattern, and improved fluidity of movement. Moreover, parents learn techniques to help improve their child's pencil grip, body awareness, posture and confidence.

**Lovin' Literacy & Happy Handwriting** (Combination Rate of \$550.00!!!! *Includes initial screening and 1 ½ hour sessions from July 6<sup>th</sup> until August 3rd*) This allows children to participate in both groups described above one right after the other.

**Writing Wizards – Grades 2-8** (\$375.00: *Includes a weekly 1 hour session from July 6<sup>th</sup> until August 3rd*) Groups are conducted by Tovah Segelman, a reading specialist and speech-language pathologist. Using the "Project Read: Framing Your Thoughts" Writing Program children will learn to write descriptive sentences, paragraphs, and stories as they learn the fundamentals of writing.

The program teaches written language sequentially and systematically and uses multi-sensory teaching strategies to help children with all learning styles to successfully express their thoughts. In addition to learning the foundation of a sentence combining a noun and a verb, the children will learn how to include prepositional phrases, adjectives, and adverbs into their writing. Watch your child's weekly spelling sentences transform from "I like to play soccer" to "After school, the excited soccer team players kicked the black and white soccer ball around the grassy field into the other team's goal to win the Championship game!"
